What a month October has been for me! After a week in Medjugorje, I have had a week on the further Camino, walking 102km to Santiago de Compostela. As you can see from the photograph, we arrived! Unlike the south of Spain, where there have been terrible floods and storms, the north-west of Spain was blessed with beautiful sunshine. For me, personally, these two pilgrimages have been a tremendous way of dealing with the changes to life that I have gone through recently,

with illness, and the death of my mother and sister. It was in their memory, and to pray for myself and for all of our parishioners, and others in


need, that I did these two pilgrimages in a spirit of penitence and intercession for healing.

As we begin November, it is time to get back down to the ordinary work of Parish Priest again. One of the joys of this last week was to hear that the Holy Father has written an Encyclical Letter on the Sacred Heart of Jesus, called *Dilexit Nos.* As we have already started our preparation for consecration to the Sacred Heart in the Jubilee Year, it comes as a great impetus, knowing

that such consecration to the Heart of Jesus is what the Pope wants us to focus on as we approach the Jubilee of 2025. And so, I ask you to come and join in the second 'First Friday' (transferred to this coming Friday) and participate in the First Friday devotions (prayer, confession and Holy Communion) on that day. If you missed the first 'First Friday' - start now as the first of your nine First Fridays.

One of the things I have done this summer, is to review what is important that I focus energy on. For the past eight years I have given one day a week to being on call as chaplain at Royal Stoke. I have now stepped back from this responsibility, having waited for Fr Matthew to be appointed as the new official Catholic chaplain. Please pray for him.

SAINT OF THE WEEK



St John Leonardi 1541-1609

Having started by training to be an apothecary, John decided to change course and become a priest instead. Rather than being a pharmacist, he wanted to administer the 'medicine of God'. Always with medicine before his mind, he wrote of finding the right diagnoses and fitting reme-

administered dies bv skilled physiciansmeaning spiritual cures for spiritual ailments. The first step is to seek God's glory through prayer and patience. John founded a men's religious congregation called the 'Clerics Regular of the Mother of God'. He died while caring for plague victims in 1609. Canonised in 1938.

ST JOHN'S UPDATE

It is now a year since we ceased the celebration of Mass and the Sacraments at St John's church, ten months since its formal closure as a Catholic church by the Archbishop, and eight months since the Coptic Orthodox Church took over the use of the church and presbytery on a 'lease at will'. The problem was that we were not able to sell the property because the original gift to the Diocese was designated only to be used as a Catholic church, presbytery and school in the trust deed. In order to change this, to allow the property to be sold to the Coptic Church, we had to get a change in the trust deed which had to be approved by the Charity Commissioners. After a long process, the Charity Commissioners have agreed to change the property, so that it is held as every other property in the Diocese. This means that we can now go ahead with the sale of the whole property to the Coptic Orthodox Church. A price has been agreed with them, and the proceeds of the sale of the church and presbytery will come to the Parish.
