A WORD FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

It's usually just before Christmas that people say to priests: "Oh, this must be your busy time". In reality it is Lent leading into Holy Week and Easter that are the really busy time for priests. There is quite a lot going on during this time. Not only do we have three children's Prayer & Life Workshops going on, and one adult one in our parish, but there is the normal round of Masses, together with extra things for Lent like Stations of the Cross. Then we also have feast days, Confirmation, penitential services as well as quite a number of funerals. All of this means that there is a lot going on.

At the end of the month I will have the Moderator of our Society of St John Mary Vianney visiting, Fr Emeric Colas des Francs. Many of you will remember his last visit to us just before COVID. It is a great encouragement to have Fr Emeric with me for just over a week. We will be going off to give a couple of days of prayer for priests elsewhere around the country as well as one here in North Staffs.

The preparations for Holy Week and Easter are under way. You will be pleased to hear that we have more converts this year than I can remember, who will be baptized or received at the Easter Vigil, together with candidates for Confirmation. It has been quite a task instructing them all and getting them ready to receive the Sacraments this Easter. There are also other enquirers who are coming regularly to hear about the Catholic Faith. This is a wonderful sign of renewal. Please let me know if you discover anyone who would like to consider

becoming a Catholic and starting catechesis.

This Jubilee Year has other events which I have to prepare for. In July we will have a Eucharistic Congress for the Deanery. I am taking responsibility for organising this, so please do lend a hand if you are willing and able to help in the preparations. Around the same time I will be organising our Valladolid Old Boys reunion for the Jubilee Year. This year it takes place in Valladolid, in the College itself.

So you see there are lots of things going on at the moment and through the rest of the year. I am pleased that my health and personal circumstances can now allow me to get back to doing all these things, as I like to be active. And I am grateful to have parishioners who are very supportive. Thank you so much.

SAINT OF THE WEEK



St Jan Sarkander 1576-1620

St Jan was a Polish-Czech priest. He had been married for a short time when his wife died. He then pursued a vocation to the priesthood. He was ordained at the age of 33 in the middle of the controversy with Protestants, and entered the fray to defend the Catholic Faith, alongside his work as a Parish priest. He had to leave his home when it was invaded by Protestant armies, and sought sanctuary in Poland, taking the opportunity to make a pilgrimage to Our Lady of Czestochowa. On his return was arrested on false accusations in order to silence him, he was then tortured for a month before being martyred.

N STAFFS EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS

As an initiative for the Jubilee Year, we will be having a Deanery Eucharistic Congress, called "Come to his Eucharistic Heart". A Eucharistic Congress is a moment in the life of the Church of a particular area when we stop and turn our attention to the presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. It is not a conference but it includes a conference event. It will be taking place from Thursday 10th to Saturday 12th July, and will be based in Tunstall, at Sacred Heart Church and St Margaret Ward Academy, though it will really be taking place across the whole Deanery.

The programme will begin with a Deanery Jubilee Year Mass celebrated by His Grace, the Archbishop on Thursday 10th July at Sacred Heart Church, Tunstall at 7pm. This will be followed by the opening of the Congress with a talk, a Holy Hour, and all-night Eucharistic Adoration.

The Friday will be a programme for schools in which all the Catholic Schools of North Staffordshire are invited to participate. This will take place in each school with parts of the day shared through live streaming.

On Friday evening, we invite all parishioners to come for the opening of the conference part of the Congress. There will be Mass, a talk, and Holy Hour and once again all night Adoration. The Congress continues on Saturday with a full programme of talks, workshops and times of prayer, ending with Mass and a Procession of the Blessed Sacrament presided over by Bishop Timothy Menezes.

Please keep these dates free, and come and participate in the Eucharistic Congress, and pray for it now, that it will be a really great celebration for our Jubilee Year and will inspire Catholics in our Deanery.
